The Icelandic biological society announces the Biology in Iceland conference on November 11th and 12th 2011. The conference is open to contributions addressing biological questions in all fields of biology. Talk and poster sessions will be divided up according to topics, with hopefully no more than three parallel sessions. Those interested to organize special topic sessions are encouraged to contact the conference organizers, by September 10th the latest. Each session will start with a 30 min. plenary talk, succeeded by shorter talks.
